Senior Mobile Ballot Drop-Off Day

Volunteer Voting Assistance for Elderly, Disabled and Other Voters Challenged by Isolation or Illness

- Live in senior housing, a group home, or board and care?
- Can't get to the polls, and not sure how to drop off your ballot?
- Can't or don't want to mail in your ballot?
- Quarantining and don't know how to vote?
- Or know someone in this situation?

There's help!

Community volunteers and the Contra Costa County Clerk-Recorder-Elections are working together to offer ballot drop off service for people in group or congregate living settings. Volunteers will pick up signed and sealed ballots from residential homes and drop them in an official secure ballot drop-off box.

Contra Costa Clerk-Recorder-Elections new VoterMobile, a secure mobile voting trailer, will park for a few hours in each area of the county (West, central, East) for volunteers to drop off ballots. Other official dropoff boxes will also be used. The VoterMoblie visiting these sites on Monday cannot be used for live voting, but will have this capacity for future elections.

Volunteers will be in pairs, trained, wear face coverings and gloves and maintain social distance.

Service is by request. Volunteers are needed. Call or email to volunteer or to request ballot drop-off assistance.
